## **Dismissal**

All walkers will be dismissed via the Arcand street schoolyard (Daycare side). Please use the attached page to indicate daily dismissal (bus, walker, Daycare) for this week only. Moving forward, parents are asked to use their child's agenda to advise of dismissal procedures.

## **Drop Off Procedures at Our School**

Thank you for observing safety rules when driving your children to and from school. Children are not allowed to be dropped off, **unsupervised**, before 7:55 A.M., as there is no staff on supervision before that time.

The health and safety of our entire school community is of paramount importance. <u>Double parking,</u> <u>vehicles driving in the wrong direction, children exiting vehicles in the middle of the street, small</u> <u>children running unaccompanied, making a U-turn in the school drop-off and pick-up zone and vehicles</u> <u>parking along the NO STOPPING zone, can all lead to very dangerous situations for our children</u>. We encourage our parents to walk with their child(ren) to school, to allow students who are old enough to ride their bicycle or walk, or carpool with other families, in order to reduce congestion on neighbouring streets.
