## Morning Entry

We remind families that all students should enter the school through the schoolyard each morning.

The front door is reserved exclusively for students arriving on special buses who require additional support and supervision.

Students who arrive at the front door before 8:00 AM will be redirected to the schoolyard.

Students arriving after 8:00 AM must use the front door so their late arrival can be recorded. Please note that excessive lateness is monitored and followed up as needed.

Please also remember that the front of the school is not a drop-off zone. For everyone's safety, vehicles may not stop or park in this area during morning entry.

Thank you for your cooperation in helping us maintain a safe and smooth start to the school day.



## Cold Weather Protocol

As temperatures continue to drop, we kindly remind parents and guardians to ensure that students come to school dressed appropriately for winter conditions. Students go outside daily for recess unless the weather reaches extreme cold thresholds, and proper clothing helps keep them comfortable, safe, and ready to enjoy their time outdoors.

Please make sure your child comes to school with:

- A warm winter coat
- Snow pants
- A hat
- Waterproof mittens or gloves
- A scarf or neck warmer
- Winter boots
- An extra pair of dry socks, if possible

We also encourage labeling all items with your child's name, as winter gear often looks alike and can easily be misplaced.
